



# Our Care Management Program

## How Care Management Helps You:

- **Personal Care Coordinator:**

You'll have a dedicated Care Coordinator who works with you and your doctor to create a personalized care plan.

- **Symptom Monitoring:**

Your Care Coordinator will check in with you regularly and update your doctor on any changes in your health.

- **Medication & Appointment Help:**

Need a refill? Have trouble remembering appointments? Your Care Coordinator can help.

- **Health Education & Local Resources:**

Get guidance on managing your condition and access to helpful services like transportation or support groups.

- **A Familiar, Friendly Voice:**

Most patients stay with the same Care Coordinator, so you always have someone who knows your health history.

### Insurance Coverage

This program is covered by Medicare and could be covered-in-full if you have a secondary insurance. Full coverage depends on your secondary insurance carrier or Medicare Replacement Plan Coverage. Although Medicare developed this program, you do not need to be a Medicare beneficiary to take advantage of these valuable services. Most Medicare Advantage and commercial plans also cover this benefit.

Like other healthcare services, our Care Management program is subject to your annual insurance deductible, coinsurance, and copay. Depending on your specific benefits there may be a minimal fee associated with the program.
